2004 Local Grantmaking - \$20,000

Alzheimer's Association, \$1,050

To offer Respite Scholarships for families caring for a loved one in their home through their Respite Assistance Program.

Dubuque Area Youth Leadership Council, \$1,000

To develop leadership curriculum for their Youth Leadership Day which provides training to 100 plus students on an annual basis.

Dubuque Community Y, \$1,000

To assist the YWCA Domestic Violence Program with materials to aid in the empowerment and education of the effects of domestic violence, the provision of services to victims and their children, and community awareness.

Dubuque County Extension, \$1,579

To support the Welcoming and Retaining Diversity in Dubuque program which provides outreach services, networking opportunities, and empowerment techniques to low-income and minority populations.

Dubuque Museum of Art, \$1,000

To provide experiential and interactive educational opportunities for children ages 2-8 and their families with the development of their Family Discovery Center.

Dubuque Senior High School, \$1,132.30

To support the creation of Success Rams, a mentoring program designed to pair up mentors with students at risk of not graduating and performing low academically.

Four Mounds Foundation, \$1,800

To provide support for an ecological restoration project of the Youth Empowerment Services as they restore rare savanna and natural prairie areas to six zones at the Four Mounds Estate and teach sound ecological practices.

Great Midwestern Educational Theater Company, \$1,000

To make possible a storytelling and participation theater literacy program for PreK and Kindergarten children.

Helping Services for Northeast Iowa, \$1,382.3

To support their Puppet PALS program as they continue serving the students in our Dubuque public and parochial schools.

Loras College, \$625

To support ten low-income students with one-year scholarships to provide them with the ability to enroll in the Loras College Foreign Language for Elementary Students program.

Mt. Pleasant Home, \$881.39

To install a sound/PA system in their dining room to enable them to provide activities and special events for their residents.

Northeast Iowa School of Music, \$1,900

To provide home materials, on-site instrument kits, and teacher's materials for their Kindermusik classes offered to low and moderate income children.

Presentation Lantern, \$1,800

To help their Speaking of Health program establish a consistent site where women, especially immigrant women, can informally network with others regarding health care issues.

Riverview Center, \$1,800

To provide supplies for their Prevention Education program which empowers girls and women, fosters empathy in males and develops social skills that emphasize respect, equality and non-violent conflict resolution.

Stonehill Franciscan Services, \$1,050

To provide the materials needed in building a raised garden which brings together elementary students and residents of the Stonehill Care Center to promote intergenerational relationships, an appreciation of nature, and the benefits of good nutrition.

Visiting Nurses Association, \$1,000

To provide staff training, teaching materials and safety supplies to their Child Safe Program which seeks to increase the safety of the home environment for Dubuque County children who are at risk for child abuse or neglect by providing need-specific parent education.
