Agency Endowment

Agency endowment funds give nonprofits the opportunity to build a stable funding stream for the future.

As a Community Foundation nonprofit partner, your organization will also enjoy additional benefits and resources to help you connect with donors and strengthen your organization.

#### How it works

An agency endowment is a long-term fund held, managed and invested by the Community Foundation of Greater Dubuque on behalf of a nonprofit that receives annual distributions for unrestricted use.

Your board determines how much you would like to invest long term, establishing an endowment fund with a minimum gift of \$10,000, or an acorn fund with a minimum gift of \$2,500 and a commitment to reach \$10,000 in five years.

The fund remains as an asset on your nonprofit's books and you or your donors can add to it at any time. Each year, a percentage of the fund's earnings is distributed as a grant to your organization, supporting programs and services forever.

#### Long-term benefits

- The fund grows over time and provides a source of lasting support.
- Donors who contribute \$50 or more to your endowment are eligible to receive the Endow Iowa 25% State Tax Credit.
- The Community Foundation receives gifts, manages the fund and investments, files tax returns, and distributes income directly to your nonprofit.
- Your donors can create a legacy by leaving a bequest to your endowment.
- Donors can make complex gifts, such as gifts of grain, stock, life insurance or property.
- You gain access to donors who structure all gifting through the Foundation and who can name your agency as a partial beneficiary of their philanthropy.
